



Desserts Can Contribute To Meal Planning Grain Requirements

Sara Lee Frozen Bakery offers many desserts with varying amounts of Grain Equivalents that can fit into any menu

What is a Grain Equivalent?

• A grain equivalent is the amount of grain in a portion of food used in menu planning to make sure recipients get enough grains at meals and throughout the day

What is a Grain Equivalent Requirement?

- The total amount of servings of grain products needed to meet the nutritional requirements for a planned menu.
- Most Long Term Care Facilities and Assisted Living Communities base their menus off of the Recommended Dietary Allowances, which is usually 6 or more grain servings per day, or 2 or more grain servings per meal.

Main Meal Menu Building Example

In Long Term Care and Assisted Living Facilities, the 'Main Meal' is typically served midday and should have 2 grain equivalents. Depending on how many grain equivalents are served in the entree category, a variety of different dessert types can be chosen.

- Potatoes do NOT count as a grain product, so they are not included in the grain equivalents.
- Dinner rolls, rice, noodles, and other grains are included in grain equivalent counts
